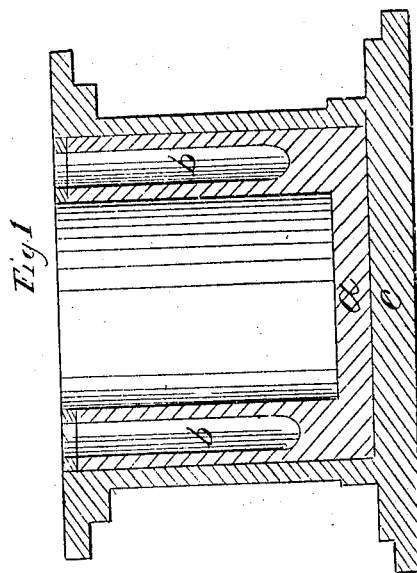
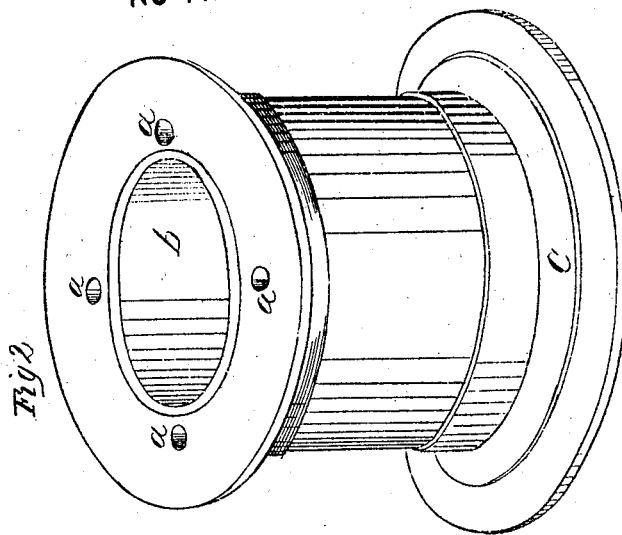

The schedule required in these Latter Patent are making part of the same, containing a description in the words of the said Israel Hayward himself, his improvement in the construction of an Ink-standish or case, as follows:

This invention consists in lining the standish with glass. The standish is made of stone or iron taken from the blast or air furnace, and moulded in sand; a certain degree of heat is infused into the standish and melted glass taken from the pot with a common blow pipe, is blown into the standish which completely lines the inside thereof; copper pins are pinned in the sides, designed for the pens when out of use, previous to blowing in the glass which being drawn out leaves cases for the pens separate from the ink.
